

Proof of Identification for Entities

(Corporate, Unincorporated, Clubs & Societies, Charities, Churches & Places of Worship and Trusts)

We are required by law to verify the existence of your business, club and charity etc. This is to protect you against the risk of identity fraud and allows the Society to comply with money laundering regulations.

Constitution documents should have

- Name of Entity
- Purpose of Entity
- How the Entity will be run
- Who the Key people are and their title

Minutes of Meeting Documents should have

- Confirmation of agreement to open an account with Dudley Building Society
- Who is authorised to operate the account and confirmed signing rules
- The minutes should be signed by at least 2 key persons of the entity

Where letters are acceptable as identification of the entity they should be on entity letter headed paper.

Minutes of Meeting (See above)	
Constitution Document (See Above) or Letter on headed paper with details	

Charities, Church's and Places of Worship	
Verifying the Charity/Church	Verification of Operators
An unregistered charity will require Minutes of Meeting (See above) and Constitution Document (See Above) or Letter on headed paper with details	See Private Individual List
A registered charity will have required minutes of meeting (See above) and charity commission registration details/number	
A register limited charity will be required charity commission registration details/number and Companies House Number	
Certificate of Worship issued by the general register office

Verifying the Trust	Verification of Trustees
Copy of the Trust Deed	See Private Individual List
Confirmation of any professional registrations if the trust itself is a company
